They sell separate sets of all these at Dollar Tree! Or buy index cards and have children make their very own flash cards \bigcirc . Ms. (O'Neill) Shanahan also recommended a site that sells practice books for all subjects too in her Welcome Letter.

***In order for students to complete the challenging and rigorous math work in 4th and 5th grade <u>ALL students MUST have their Math Fact Tables memorized.</u>

Many students may already know these, but please practice them over the summer because if you don't you may forget them. ***

Uniforms are expected to be worn each and every day: Navy blue pants/skirts (no blue jeans), navy blue polo shirts, and gym shoes (open toed shoes and sandals are prohibited). Uniforms are on sale at the school.
